
60 Photos Of The Game Of Thrones Cast You've Never Seen Before




The Night is Dark and Full of Terrors


Khaleesi and Ryan Gosling


Calligraphy Lessons

Earl Grey and Pink Sneakers




Jon Snow the Makeup Artist

Game of Thrones has won 59 Emmys out of 160 nominations over the course of their eight seasons on HBO, breaking a few records along the way. In 2015, the show broke the record for the most Emmy wins in a single year, with 12 wins out of 24 nominations. In 2016, it broke the record for most wins in history with 38 total Emmy wins. And in 2019, Game of Thrones broke the record for most nominations in a single year, with 32 nominations for the final season. It's obviously an amazing show, but those numbers are impressive nonetheless.


Game of Muppets
